Grand temple awaits Lord Ram in Ayodhya: Keshav Maurya

Uttar Pradesh deputy chief minister Keshav Prasad Maurya on Monday said a verdict on the Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid land dispute may be a prerogative of the Supreme Court but a grand temple for Lord Ram will be built.

It will now be impossible to install a single stone bearing the name of Mughal emperor Babur, the BJP leader said, days after the RSS declared it will not hesitate to launch an agitation for Ram temple at Ayodhya if needed. "I have clearly said time and again on the issue of construction of a temple in Ayodhya that whenever there is a verdict on Ayodhya, it is the prerogative of the Supreme Court. But a grand temple for Ram Lalla will be built," he said. "Now, it is simply impossible to install even a single stone bearing the name of Babur there," he added.

The Babri Masjid was demolished in 1992 by rightwing Hindus who believe it was built on the birthplace of Lord Ram. Stating that

neither the petitioner nor the government can do anything in a matter pending before the court, Maurya said the installation of a grand statue of Lord Ram should not be linked to construction of a Ram temple.
