# Opp parties question CM dharna stance

State BJP, CPI-M and Cong condemn Mamata for her attempt to rescue police commissioner, violating laws and constitutional provisions

The BJP, CPI-M and Congress today condemned chief minister Mamata Banerjee's dharna in protest against last night CBI action against police commissioner and questioned her "motive" to go to rescue of police commissioner violating laws and constitutional provisions.

While Union minister and senior BJP leader Prakash Javadekar today claimed that Miss Banerjee was on a dharna to save herself from the CBI, CPI-M central committee member and MLA Sujan Chakraborty said that the chief minister was acting out a political drama in a bid to cover the corruption of multi-crore Saradha chit fund scam and evade her arrest.

Metro channel on Sunday night over the CBI's attempt to question Kolkata police commissioner Rajeev Kumar in connection with the chit fund scams, insisting it stifled the spirit of "Constitution and federalism".

Mr Javadekar, during a Press conference at the state BJP's headquarters, said: "This is not Narendra Modi's emergency but Mamata Banerjee's emergency in Bengal. She is on a dharna to save herself from the CBI."

Mr Javadekar said that the saffron party will combat any "attempt by TMC" to disrupt law and order situation in the state. He alleged that chief minister Mamata Banerjee-led government has murdered the democracy in the state.

"West Bengal Opposition party activists are being killed and being stopped from taking out rallies. Choppers of BJP leaders Amit Shah, Yogi

Adityanath and Smriti Irani were not allowed to land. Is this democracy? Is this not an emergency? She is abusing the Modi government," the senior BJP leader said.

Mr Javadekar claimed that constitutional order has completely broken down in the

state, but stopped short of demanding imposition of President's rule in West Bengal. "We would say both law and order and Constitutional order has completely broken down in the state."

On whether the BJP would demand imposition of Pres-

ident's rule in the state, he replied, "We won't say anything as of now." Wondering how come IPS officers in plain clothes can sit on a political dharna along with the chief minister, the senior BJP leader said CBI officers were stopped from doing their duty, allegedly to "protect" the chit fund evidences in Kolkata police chief's possession from falling into the hands of the federal probe agency.

Bengal Director General of Police Virendra, State Security Advisor Surajit Kar Purkayastha and Kumar were with the chief minister at the dharna site on Sunday night.

Denying TMC's claims that the BJP was using the CBI to serve its own political purpose, Javadekar said: "The CBI was investigating the chit fund cases as per the orders of the Supreme Court."

CPI-M leader Sujan Chakraborty said that the

chief minister was trying to evade her arrest hence playing out a political drama.

"She and her party supporters illegally occupied the Metro channel to play this drama. But people are eagerly waiting to know what were the valuable information that was concealed, why miss Banerjee visited CP's residence and why she is desperate to save Rajeev Kumar," he said.

Chief minister Mamata Banerjee rushing to city police chief Rajeev Kumar's house following a visit by a CBI team in connection is a desperate attempt to cover up the traces of an act which is being stage-managed by chief minister Banerjee and Prime Minister Narendra Modi, leader of the Opposition, Abdul Mannan said today.

While the CBI dragging feet over the Saradha chit fund scam initially was found

surprising, people are left clueless about the chief minister's alacrity in rushing to the city police chief's residence when she did not involve herself in similar activities when CBI arrested one of her Cabinet colleagues as well as party MPs, Mannan added.

Putting up a brave face after Congress president Rahul Gandhi expressed solidarity with the chief minister, Mannan said our leader will oppose BJP at all levels. But our leadership has not reined us in from drawing attention to the unholy alliance between the chief minister and the Prime Minister, he contended.

In Bengal, we will continue our fight against both Trinamul Congress and BJP despite what our national leadership is doing by showing solidarity to the dharna staged by Mamata Banerjee," said Somen Mitra, state Congress president, today.

## Modi, Shah need to be defeated to 'save democracy': Kejriwal on CBI vs Mamata

Delhi chief minister and AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal on Monday slammed Prime Minister Narendra Modi and BJP chief Amit Shah over developments in West Bengal, saying they needed to be defeated in the upcoming Lok Sabha polls "to save democracy" in the country.

He said the "Modi-Shah duo was the biggest danger" facing the country and charged the two leaders with trying to "murder" democracy.

Delhi BJP president Manoj Tiwari hit back at Kejriwal saying he should not talk about democracy because he has "robbed" it through his "falsehoods and conspiracies" in



the city.

In a statement, Kejriwal said: "The Modi government is bent on murdering democracy. Isn't it illegal and undemocratic that a team of 40 CBI officials enters the residence of a police commissioner?"

"The Modi-Shah duo should be defeated to save the democracy," he said.

Tiwari said that leaders like Mamata Banerjee and Kejriwal were "betraying" democra-

cy by going against the directives of courts.

"The CBI went to West Bengal on directions of the Supreme Court. Leaders like Kejriwal are supporting Mamata Banerjee because they are scared of Modi who is dedicated to end corruption," he claimed. The failed attempt by the CBI to question Kolkata Police Commissioner Rajeev Kumar in connection with the Saradha and Rose Valley chit fund scams on Sunday became the latest flashpoint between the BJP-led Centre and West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee.

Kejriwal had talked to Banerjee on Sunday over phone as the incident blew into a political slugfest and expressed solidarity with her while terming the action as "completely bizarre

and anti-democratic". The AAP convener, who himself is a bitter critic of the Modi government, in his statement on Monday drew a parallel between the West Bengal incident and experiences of his own government in Delhi. "Just as Modi tried to besiege the Commissioner of West Bengal yesterday, four years ago he snatched away the anti-corruption bureau from us by sending paramilitary forces," he charged.

He further alleged the PM got 33 cases registered against him and police raided his residence and searched his bedroom on his instance.

"If Modi j misuses Central agencies to violate the rights of the state governments, the country will not survive," Kejriwal said.

## Oppn parties meet EC over EVM concerns

Leaders of several Opposition parties petitioned the Election Commission (EC) on Monday and demanded that 50 per cent of EVM results should be cross-checked with voter verifiable paper audit trails (VVPATs) before declaring final Lok Sabha election results.

Leaders of 23 political parties met Chief Election Commissioner Sunil Arora and Election Commissioner Ashok Lavasa, seeking redressal of the issue of alleged tampering of electronic voting machines (EVMs) before Lok Sabha polls.

The leaders told the EC the people of the country doubted the efficacy of EVMs and this issue needs to be redressed.

The EC said it has heard the concerns of the parties on their demands related to the counting of VVPAT slips and assured them that the issues raised would be "deliberated and examined".

"While considering the averments made by the political parties, the Commission shall also keep in view

the pronouncements made by the different courts as well as the report expected shortly from the Indian Statistical Institute on the subject, besides the overall administrative and operational feasibility on the ground, before firming up any response," the EC said in a statement.

The Opposition parties had earlier sought moving back to the ballot paper system, but after the EC cate-

gorically ruled it out, they changed their strategy and are now demanding matching of results of 50 per cent EVMs with VVPATs.

"We are writing to you in most trying times. The times when each and every institution built and strengthened over decades, for safeguarding democracy and the rule of law, is sought to be subverted by those who have scant respect for people's will.

"In these trying and testing times, we are writing to you as members of an exalted constitutional institution, tasked with the responsibility of ensuring free and fair elections, which in turn is the bedrock of democracy and has repeatedly been held to be part of the unamendable basic structure of the Indian Constitution," according to a memorandum signed by leaders of all 23 parties, including Con-

gress president Rahul Gandhi and NCP supremo Sharad Pawar, to the poll panel.

The memorandum also said if the difference of votes bagged by the winner and his nearest rival is less than 5 per cent, "mandatory counting of paper trail from VVPAT should be carried out in each polling station... If there is a difference in counting of votes between EVM and VVPAT, then the result in counting from VVPAT should prevail."

After the meeting, Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha Ghulam Nabi Azad said, "If a vote polled for one party goes to another party, it is against democracy."

Azad told reporters that the parties have demanded that the EC removes the "shortcomings" in EVMs.

He said parties wanted to revert to the old paper ballot system but since there is no time left for Lok Sabha polls, they have demanded bringing in transparency in the EVM system.

"We have demanded that be it Lok Sabha or assembly elections, 50 per cent votes be matched with paper trail of votes and the EC should not destroy the results of

VVPAT machines," he said.

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu said 23 parties representing 69 per cent of the voters have met the EC.

"Even now they are counting only 1 per cent (of VVPAT). We have demanded total transparency. Even developed countries are using ballot papers. But since there is no time we have demanded that 50 per cent VVPAT slips be counted. For democracy, for creating confidence, they can do that job. Since everybody is having a doubt it is the duty of the Election Commission to convince people that it is undoubtable," he said.

The delegation included Ghulam Nabi Azad, Mallikarjun Kharge, Ahmed Patel and Anand Sharma of the Congress, Chandrababu Naidu (TDP), Majid Memon (NCP), Derek O'Brien (Trinamul), Ramgopal Yadav (SP), Satish Mishra (BSP), Omar Abdullah (NC), Mohd Salim and T K Rangarajan (CPI-M), Manoj Jha (RJD), Sanjay Singh (AAP), D Raja (CPI), Danish Ali (JD-S), N K Premchandran (RSP), Badruddin Ajmal (AIUFD) and K G Kenye (NPF).

## Plea in HC to provide free legal aid to Indians abroad

A plea has been moved in the Delhi High Court seeking directions to the Centre to frame a policy to provide free legal aid to Indian citizens living abroad.

NGO Pravasi Legal Cell filed the public interest litigation claiming that India has the world's largest diaspora according to the United Nations.

The petition claimed that over 17 million people born in India now live elsewhere in the world and of these, many are semi-skilled and low-skilled workers.

"One of the biggest problems faced by such workers is that they do not have any knowledge about the local laws or how their rights are protected in such countries because of which they face violation of their basic rights on foreign land due to lack of any legal aid," the plea filed through advocate Jose Abraham read.

The NGO also said in its petition that the Union Minister of State for External Affairs, in reply to a query in the Lok Sabha, had said that around 7,850 Indians are lodged in jails abroad, with over 2,000 in Saudi Arabia.

"Most of them are under trials or victim of fraud. Most of such cases against

Indian workers abroad could have either been avoided or saved from prosecution had there been proper legal assistance at the right time," the plea claimed.

The NGO said that under Article 39-A of the Constitution of India, the government has the duty to provide free legal aid to its citizens which would include those "who cannot access justice due to economic and other disabilities while living abroad".

It has said that the objective can be achieved with the support and assistance of the Indian missions abroad.

## Man held for obscene tweet about Priyanka Vadra

Days after an obscene tweet with a morphed picture of Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra was posted on the social media platform, police said on Monday the accused person has been arrested and sent to jail. Yogi Surajnath, a resident of this north Bihar town who describes himself as a 'bhakt' (devotee) of Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the social media, was arrested from his residence in Binodpur locality, Town police station SHO Ranjan Kumar said.

While Surajnath is said to be an avid follower of the 'BJP's Mission 2019' on Twitter, BJP's district president

Manoj Rai asserted this person has no association with the party.

Kumar said the Bihar police cyber cell had received an emailed complaint from social activist Shahin Sayyad

about Surajnath's tweet of 30 January that carried a morphed image of Vadra, who was recently appointed the Congress party's general secretary for east Uttar Pradesh by her brother and

the party president, Rahul Gandhi. The SHO said the cyber cell traced Surajnath's location to Katihar, after which the district police arrested him and a case has been filed against him.

**Goa Cong seeks action:** A Goa Congress delegation Monday met state Director General of Police Muktesh Chander seeking registration of a case against an unidentified person for a "distasteful and offensive" social media post on senior party leader Priyanka Gandhi Vdra.

The delegation, led by Goa Pradesh Mahila Congress Committee president Pratima Coutinho, alleged that the "smear campaign" against Priyanka was being carried out by the BJP's IT Cell.

## 'Modi-led Kauravas will be drubbed by Rahul in polls'

The coming Lok Sabha elections will witness the "second Kurukshetra war" in which the Narendra Modi-led "Kauravas" will face a drubbing by the Congress party led by Rahul Gandhi, veteran AICC leader A K Antony has said.

Inaugurating a Congress march ahead of the Lok Sabha polls on Sunday, Antony said the "Lok Sabha election is a war to save the country."

"The 2019 Lok Sabha election will witness a second Kurukshetra war in which the Kauravas led by Narendra Modi will be destroyed by Rahul Gandhi. This year's elec-

tion is not simply any other Parliament election.

This is a war to save the country, to save the Constitution, its morals and values, constitutional institutions and other threats faced by the country," Antony said.

Speaking at the 'Janama-ha Yatra', Antony lashed out at the RSS and PM Narendra Modi and said the Congress does not need any lessons of nationalism from the RSS and the BJP. "RSS and Modi haven't grown big enough to teach nationalism to the Indian National Congress... the Indian National Congress doesn't need any lessons on nationalism from the RSS and BJP," Antony said.
